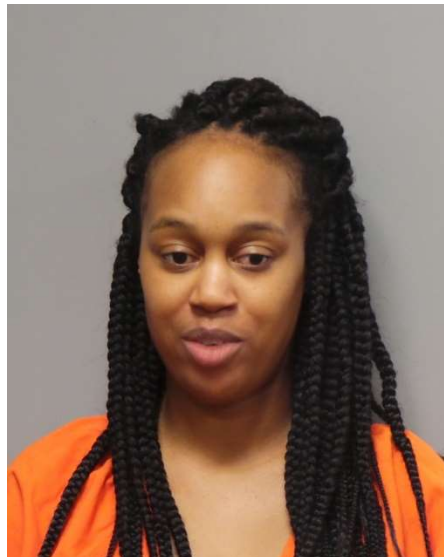

Update: Disturbance/Shots Fired

In reference to the report of shots fired in the 700 block of Country Manor Drive, the St. Louis County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has issued charges of *Assault 1st Degree* and *Armed Criminal Action* with a \$20,000 bond on:

Terriashye Powell
Female
35 years old
Resident of East St. Louis, IL

Powell's Mugshot:



Powell was temporarily staying at the home in the 700 block Country Manor Drive. Powell admitted to Creve Coeur Police Detectives that she fired several shots at a relative inside the home and outside the home. She was taken into custody at the scene by Creve Coeur Police Officers and several firearms were recovered.

We believe this was not a random act of violence but rather an isolated incident between the suspect and victim, who are acquainted.

Original Release: January 3, 2019

At approximately 9:45AM, the Creve Coeur Police Department responded to a report of a shots fired in the area of the 700 blk of Country Manor Drive.

Upon arrival Officers encountered two subjects, one male and one female, that had been involved in a disturbance, during which a series of shots had been fired. No one had been injured and the firearm was recovered by the Officers. The subjects are acquainted with each other, and there are no other subjects involved. The investigation is on-going, with Detectives currently on-scene.
